

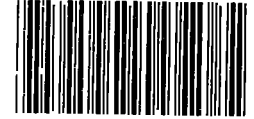

To the President of the Senate and the
Speaker of the House of Representatives

On January 5, 1983, the President's fourth special message for fiscal year 1983 was transmitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message proposes four deferrals totalling \$38,897,952 and a revision to a previously reported deferral which increases the amount deferred by \$10 million. Our report follows.


