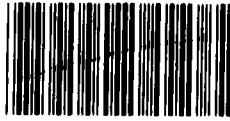

On May 8, 1984, the President's ninth special message for fiscal year 1984 was submitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message proposes one new deferral totalling \$101,999,550 and a revision to one previously reported deferral totalling \$778,000. Our report follows.
