Subject: Community Development: Census Tracts With High Poverty Levels in
 Medium-Sized to Large Metropolitan Statistical Areas

Dear Mr. Chairman:

As you requested, we have identified the census tracts that have high levels of poverty for every medium-sized to large metropolitan statistical area in the United States.¹ For each selected metropolitan statistical area, enclosure I lists the number of census tracts in which 50 percent or more of the households are at or below the poverty level,² the number of tracts in which 75 percent or more of the households are at or below the poverty level (a subset of the first number), and the total number of census tracts. For each of these census tracts, enclosure II lists the median household income and the number of households in four income ranges.

Our objectives in this review were to identify census tracts in medium-sized to large cities that met specific poverty criteria and to provide additional information on each census tract. To attain our objectives, we identified medium-sized to large metropolitan statistical areas by using data from the Department of Commerce's federal standard for metropolitan statistical areas.³ For the selected metropolitan statistical areas, we analyzed data from the 1990 Census to identify those census tracts in which households were at or below different poverty levels.⁴ For both data sources, we performed limited testing and review of existing information and determined that the data were reliable for

¹A metropolitan statistical area is defined as an area that includes either a city or other urban area with a population of 50,000 or more. We defined medium-sized to large metropolitan statistical areas as those with populations of 250,000 or more in the 1990 Census. The Census Bureau defines census tracts as small, relatively permanent subdivisions of counties that usually have between 2,500 and 8,000 people; therefore, there are multiple census tracts within each metropolitan statistical area.

²For the 1990 Census, the poverty rate was the percentage of people whose poverty status was computed and whose 1989 income was below a specific level. For example, the level for a family of four was \$12,674.

³Federal Information Processing Standards Publication 8-6, Department of Commerce, National Institute of Standards and Technology (Mar. 1995).

⁴Specifically, we selected populated urban tracts with median household income greater than zero. To exclude tracts with large institutionalized populations, such as prisons, we eliminated tracts if the ratio of people to households was greater than 10 to 1.
