We have made a review for the settlement of accounts of the accountable officer at the Huntington District, Corps of Engineers (Civil Functions), through May 31, 1971. The review was made pursuant to the Budget and Accounting Act, 1921 (31 U.S.C. 53), and the Accounting and Auditing Act of 1950 (31 U.S.C. 67).

Since the disbursing and accounting functions were transferred to the Finance and Accounting Center, Ohio River Division, Cincinnati, Ohio, effective June 1, 1971, we made a limited review of procedures and controls and tested such transactions as we considered appropriate. We also reviewed the applicable fiscal year 1971 reports and work-papers of the Ohio River Division Resident Audit Staff. We did not review program activities.

We found that the disbursement and revenue transactions were valid, legal and appropriate, that the Resident Audit Staff provided internal control over disbursements and revenues, and that the accountable officer effectively discharged her fiscal responsibilities.

In accordance with 8 GAO 13 the records may be stored pursuant to your agency's record management program.
