This replies to your September 8, 1978, letter in which you request "all materials filed by the Department of the Navy in connection with Protest No. 2-180988, letter of Landrey Electric Corporation."

Your letter refers to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 5 U.S.C. 552. As an agency responsible to Congress, GAO is not subject to the Freedom of Information Act. It is our policy, however, to make our records available to the public to the extent disclosure is consistent with our function and responsibilities to the Congress and is not prohibited by law. We have issued regulations concerning the availability of GAO records to the public. The regulations are contained in Part 1 of title 4 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

We are enclosing a copy of the Navy's July 1978 report on the E-1 bid protest. Enclosed materials submitted with this report (note enclosures listed on the last page) have been disclosed. Should you desire to obtain any additional information, we suggest you contact the Navy who is more likely to have copies of their proposals, specifications, and modifications.
