

To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On August 16, 1979, the President's eleventh special message for fiscal year 1979 was transmitted to the Congress Concerning Bursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special incommessage proposed four new deferrals totalling \$204.5 million as follows.
