Gentlemen:

We refer to your letter of July 27, 1981 protesting the Air Force's award of contract FO499-81-D0037 to maintain family housing, including painting unoccupied housing, at McClellan Air Force Base, California. The basis for your protest is the allegation that the Air Force improperly terminated a contract with you to paint the unoccupied housing.

We recently dismissed your protest against the termination of your contract because the matter should be considered by a contract appeals board, not our Office. Jacobs & Son Painting and Decorating, B-204105, August 6, 1981, 81-2 CPD. Since your new protest also is based solely on the complaint that your contract improperly was terminated, it does not raise any matter which is subject to our review. Therefore, we will not consider the matter further.
