To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On July 20, 1984, the President's twelfth special message for fiscal year 1984 was submitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message proposes one new deferral totalling \$8,006,000 and revisions to six previously reported deferrals totalling \$68,528,548. Our report follows.
