Subject: Community Development: Identification of Economically Distressed Areas

On March 12, 1997, a bill (H.R. 1031) was introduced in the House of Representatives that would allow the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development to designate up to 100 areas as "renewal" communities. For these communities, the bill seeks to increase the number of new jobs; form and expand small businesses; increase educational opportunities and homeownership; and foster moral renewal—by providing federal tax incentives, regulatory reform, school reform pilot projects, and homeownership incentives.

In January 1998, you asked us to identify economically distressed areas that could qualify for assistance under this bill. On the basis of discussions with your offices, we agreed to use the most recent data (1990 Census) from the Census Bureau to identify census tracts¹ that meet the bill's criteria for economic distress. Although these data are 8 to 9 years old and circumstances may have changed for any given tract, these data are the most recent available for all tracts nationwide. The bill's criteria for economic distress that have associated measures require an area to have (1) a poverty rate of at least 20 percent; (2) an unemployment rate that is at least 1.5 times

the national unemployment rate; and (3) at least 70 percent of the households with an income less than 80 percent of the locality's median income.²

Our preliminary analysis showed that using a median income measure severely restricted the number of tracts, particularly rural tracts, that could qualify for assistance. On the basis of our preliminary results, we agreed with your offices that the first two criteria would sufficiently identify economically distressed areas across the country. Consequently, this report reflects our analysis of census tracts that meet the poverty and unemployment criteria in the bill. We also agreed to identify whether the census tracts were in urban or rural areas and whether they were located in an existing federal empowerment zone (EZ) or enterprise community (EC).³ (Enc. I describes our scope and methodology on this assignment.)

We found that 9,184 census tracts meet both of the criteria for economic distress, including 1,354 census tracts in rural areas; 7,396 in urban areas; and 434 in mixed urban/rural areas (see table 1). Fourteen percent of these census tracts are located in an EZ or an EC. Enclosure II lists the census tract number for each of the 300 most-populated census tracts out of 9,184 tracts that we identified that meet the bill's poverty and unemployment criteria, along with its state, county, population, and notes indicating whether the census tract is rural, mixed urban/rural, and/or located in an EZ or EC.

²In addition, to providing specific measures related to poverty and unemployment, the bill requires that the area be one of "general distress."

³The Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993 and the Taxpayer Relief Act of 1997 authorized the designation of up to 126 communities as EZs or ECs. As of the date of this report, 105 communities had been so designated.

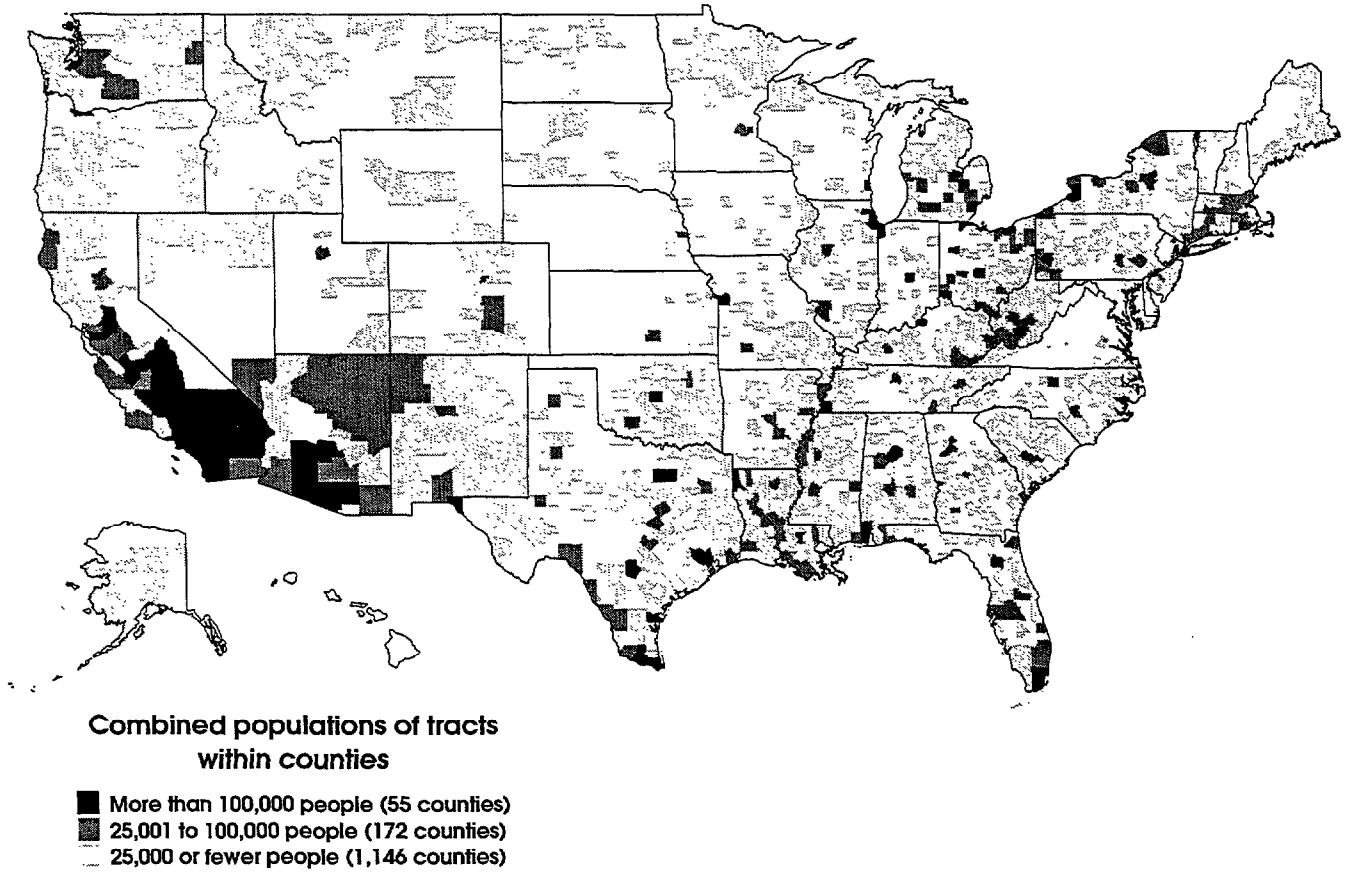
^bIn the 1990 Census, the national unemployment rate was 6.3 percent. In order to be counted in this column, a tract's unemployment rate was at least 1.5 times the 1990 Census' national unemployment rate, which was 9.45 percent.

We also found that the census tracts that meet both of the criteria for economic distress are located in the District of Columbia and 1,373 counties (out of 3,141 nationwide) among all 50 states. Figure 1 shows the counties that meet both of the criteria, and the shadings indicate the population range of the combined tracts in each of the counties for the tracts that meet both criteria. In addition, enclosure III lists each of the counties and the District of Columbia, ranked by the total population of the census tracts that meet the criteria, and enclosure IV lists counties with tracts that meet both criteria, grouped by state. Enclosures III and IV also include, for each county, the total population in the census tracts that meet the criteria, the number of census tracts in the county that meet the criteria, notes on whether census tracts are rural or mixed urban/rural census tracts, and whether the tracts are located in an EZ or EC.

SCOPE AND METHODOLOGY

To identify areas that met the poverty and unemployment criteria in H.R. 1031, we analyzed census tract and block numbering area (BNA) data, using the 1990 Census of Population and Housing.¹ We limited our analysis to census tracts with at least 50 households. A household is defined as all of the persons who occupy a housing unit, which may be a single family, one person living alone, two or more families living together, or any other group of related or unrelated persons who share living arrangements. This definition excludes persons living in institutionalized and noninstitutionalized group quarters, such as hospitals, prisons, military quarters, and college dormitories. In addition, we did not include Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands of the United States, Guam, American Samoa, the Northern Mariana Islands and any other possession of the United States in our analysis.

Using the census data, we designated each tract as either urban, rural, or mixed urban/rural. The census identifies persons as urban who live in urbanized areas (at least one place and its adjacent densely settled surrounding territory ("urban fringe") that together include at least 50,000 people) or in places of 2,500 persons outside of urbanized areas. All other persons are identified as rural residents. If more than 80 percent of a tract's residents were urban, we designated the tract as urban. If less than 20 percent of the tract's residents were urban, we designated the tract as rural. If 20 to 80 percent of a tract's residents were urban, we designated the tract as mixed urban/rural. All subsequent analyses displayed results separately for urban, rural, and mixed urban/rural tracts.

To determine a tract's poverty rate, we used the number of persons in the tract who were determined to be below the federal poverty level for 1989 and divided this by all persons for whom a poverty determination was made.² Our analysis identified all tracts that had 20 percent or more of its persons below the federal poverty levels.

¹The Census Bureau defines census tracts as small, relatively permanent statistical subdivisions of counties that usually have between 2,500 and 8,000 persons. BNAs are small statistical subdivisions of a county for grouping and numbering blocks in nonmetropolitan counties where local census statistical areas committees have not established census tracts.

²The Census Bureau determines if a person is below the poverty rate using the income and size of the family unit or unrelated individual. The Census Bureau makes this determination for all persons except institutionalized persons, persons in military group quarters and in college dormitories, and unrelated individuals under 15 years old.

To determine a tract's unemployment rate, we used the number of persons in the tract who were unemployed and divided it by the total number of persons both employed and unemployed. Census defines the unemployed as civilians 16 years and older who responded that they were not working, but were looking for work during the last 4 weeks, and were available to accept a job. Our analysis identified all tracts that had unemployment rates that were at least 150 percent of the census' 6.3 percent national average unemployment rate—that is, 9.45 percent and higher. Finally, we determined how many tracts had both a poverty rate of at least 20 percent and an unemployment rate of at least 150 percent of the national average.

To identify which of the tracts that met the poverty and unemployment criteria were part of an EZ or EC, we matched census tracts that met both criteria to census tracts in each EZ and EC, which we obtained from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. On the basis of the number of tracts that were on both lists, we determined the percent of tracts that met the poverty and unemployment criteria of H.R. 1031 and were part of an EZ or EC.

We performed our work from January through May 1998 in accordance with generally accepted government auditing standards.
