Dear Mr. Davis:


We have examined the Financial statements of the Federal Prison
 ended June 30, 1974. The examination mas node pursuant to the Covermeat Corporation Control Act (31 7. Sic. gal).

Our review, which was completed in September 1974, was made in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. It included such tests of the accounting records and financial transactions and such other auditing procedures as we considered necessary, considering the existing system of intamal controls prod prion au'izs.

This year we limited the amount of detailed audit work done on PPI, Sandstone"; Financial statements, because of the bepartupert of Justice auditors review of financial activities at pour location. Gur review placed primary emphasis on FPI, Sandstone's management of its financial resources, specifically inventory management.

Our finding g, finch were discussed : th you and other officials at the conclusion of the review, would have no significant effect upon the reliability of the financial statements for your location. However, certain observations which are within your authority and responsibility, upon which corrective action has been taken or promised, are summarized below for yous information.

1. Fri, Sandstone personnel need to comply with the dr warehouse operating procedures and exercise better controls over raw materials and supplies. For example:
 for raw materials were net prepared mail after the materials had been issued from the warehouse.

-The print shop bindery fioreaan, tho ts also the storekeaper, told us that priat shop requisitions were not zumbred now sfgned untill the day after che requisitions zere filled.
-Daring our toyize of ntocie racord card data, one inyontory item (chip board sheers) was disclosed which showed 4083 sore waits on hand on the stock record card than vere in the marenouse.
2. Hore eftectyve use of maximan/miniman inventory levels is needed at FPI, Sandatone zo assure that proner lavels of supply are maintained. For example:
-Tur review of stock record card data as of kay 31, 1974, date of physical inventory for ram materdal items, disclosed 15 ithem with stock on hand in excess of one-year needs, which sere not reported by PT, sandstone. The atock record cards ghowed that balances on hand were in excess of the maxtinn inventory level indicated for 5 of the 13 items.

Whe foma semen ikers with stock on hand under the mintmum inventory level indicated on the atock record cards for shich procuramen actien had not been considered.
--We were cold by the FPr, Sambtone busimoss manarer mad the print prouluction foreman that they have not, as a
 inventory tavols ta identify items paguiring procuroment,
 detembing the quantities of iteas to be procured.

- Wo marimu/minisus inventory levels, nor other designation of an fuventory leyon, were shown on the stock record cards For the glove factory raw metarin itans.

3. The nead for FPI, Sandstone personnel to take correctiva actions and for manegenent to monitor these actions is particularly signiffcant, because the finding axeas cited have been included in prior thternal and Gho audit reports. For example:
-." "nventory diffarances aisclosed by our August 1971 test coubts and a reviem of atoraroon requisitions and praceGures indicated a need for better materials and supplies control." (GAO, letter report, dated 0ctober 7, 1971, to Smperintendent of Industries, FPI, Smontone)
 to wsume that proper levels of zaw matertal are maintanned swat." "Te notad that on the hasis of amual usata, promurnants aither were excessitwe or were late." (bepartment of Justice ofitice of Interal hadiz, report, dated October 36,1972 , on FPI finameial actigities at Sandseone)

We ahall appreciate your comenta and adylee as to the resules of further ackion taken on these mattera, Fio mish to acknowledge the cooperacion and courtasy exteaded to our representatives by both your civillan mad imate personnel during our review.
