

IN REPLY B-196797

To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On May 20, 1980, the President's ninth special message for fiscal year 1980 was transmitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message proposes a rescission of budget authority totalling \$12.4 million and revisions to six previously transmitted deferrals increasing the amount deferred by \$130.6 million as follows:
