

Dear Mr. Chairman:

This fact sheet responds to your request that we provide data on trips taken by Department of Justice (DOJ) officials on DOJ-owned aircraft. You asked us to update certain information in our 1990 report, Government Civilian Aircraft: Use of Government Aircraft by the Attorney General and FBI Director (GAO/GGD-90-84, June 15, 1990). In discussions with the Subcommittee, we agreed to collect and summarize data on travel by DOJ officials, primarily the Attorney General and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Director, on FBI-owned aircraft. This fact sheet documents the dates of travel, types of aircraft used, itinerary, and passengers for each trip taken on FBI aircraft by DOJ officials in fiscal years 1990 through 1993 and during the first quarter of fiscal year 1994.

Results in Brief

Travel by DOJ officials on FBI aircraft decreased sharply from 96 trips in fiscal year 1990 to 31 trips in fiscal year 1993. Only three trips were taken during the first quarter of fiscal year 1994. As shown in table 1 and figure 1, of the 301 trips taken by DOJ officials between fiscal year 1990 and the first quarter of 1994, 128 (42.5 percent) and 115 (38.2 percent) of these were for travel by Attorneys General and FBI Directors, respectively. Fifty-eight (19.3 percent) were for travel primarily by other DOJ officials. The Attorneys General and FBI Directors were accompanied by an FBI security detail and frequently by other DOJ and FBI officials.



Additional information on trips taken by specific Attorneys General and FBI Directors is shown in appendix I. Appendixes II through VI document each trip taken in fiscal years 1990 through 1993 and in the first quarter of 1994.

Scope and Methodology

We obtained from the FBI lists of flights taken by DOJ officials on FBI-owned aircraft for the period October 1, 1989, through December 31, 1993. These lists provided information for each trip on date, aircraft type, flight hours, routing, and identity of the passengers. We discussed the information in those lists with FBI and DOJ officials for technical clarification. From the lists, we identified round-trips and one-way trips taken by Attorneys General, FBI Directors, and other DOJ officials. For our summary tables and figure, we identified these trips by the highest level official on the flight. As agreed with the Subcommittee, we neither obtained information on the

purpose of each trip nor independently verified the data provided by the FBI. We limited our work to flights on FBI aircraft because other DOJ agency aircraft are generally not used by the Attorney General and FBI Director.

As part of our work, we took the names of individuals listed as passengers and identified them by position title and organizational unit, on the basis of information provided by DOJ and the FBI. When we were unable to identify passengers by position title, we listed them by the names shown on the flight lists provided by the FBI.

On May 16, 1994, we met with the Unit Chief of the FBI's Aviation and Special Operation Unit. On May 24, 1994, we met with the Assistant Director for DOI's Facilities and Administrative Services staff. These officials are responsible for the activities discussed in this fact sheet. Both officials agreed with the information in the fact sheet and provided clarification and technical corrections, which we included. In addition, the Assistant Director pointed out that, according to an internal DOI review, executive travel on all DOI aircraft accounted for less than 1/2 of one percent of the total aircraft usage in fiscal year 1993. Further, the Assistant Director said that the overwhelming use of DOI aircraft was for mission-related activities, such as surveillance, prisoner transportation, intelligence, special operations, etc.

As agreed with the Subcommittee, unless you publicly announce its contents earlier, we plan no further distribution of this fact sheet until 10 days after its issue date. At that time, we will send copies to the Attorney General, the Director of the FBI, and the Director of the Office of Management and Budget. Copies will also be made available to others upon request.
