**To The President of the Senate and the
Speaker of the House of Representatives**

On May 2, 1995, the President submitted to the Congress his fifth special impoundment message for fiscal year 1995. The fifth special message reports three proposed rescissions of budget authority. We have reviewed the proposed rescissions and found them to be in accordance with the Impoundment Control Act, 2 U.S.C. § 681, *et seq.*

The President must make the funds proposed for rescission available for obligation unless the Congress completes action on a rescission bill within the first 45-day period of continuous Congressional session after the day such proposal is received by the Congress. 2 U.S.C. § 683 (b).

Enclosure I provides a list of the rescissions as proposed by the President.
