To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On October 1, 1979, we received copies of the President's first special message for fiscal year 1980 that was transmitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message contains one rescission of \$113,673 and 30 deferrals totalling almost \$1,003.2 million of budget authority.

Our comments on the information submitted in the special message of October 1, 1979, are enclosed.

GAO COMMENTS ON THE PRESIDENT'S FIRST SPECIAL MESSAGE FOR FISCAL YEAR 1980

Except as noted below, we conclude that the information provided in the rescission and deferral proposals is correct and that the actions being proposed have been clearly and accurately stated.

INTERNATIONAL COMMUNICATION AGENCY

Based on the current legislative calendar, the 45-day period of continuous session during which the funds may be withheld pending congressional consideration of a rescission bill ended on November 15, 1979, without the Congress having passed such a bill. Under section 1012(b) of the Impoundment Control Act, the funds proposed for rescission must be made available for obligation. We will monitor this account to determine when the subject budget authority is apportioned by the Office of Management and Budget to the agency and the funds are allotted to the program.

Our review of this deferral establishes that an additional \$14,888,100 was deferred since the date on which this special message was sent to the Congress. OMB informs us that a subsequent deferral message will soon be sent to the Congress to address the changes affecting this account.
