On December 12, 1978, we received copies of the President's fourth special message for fiscal year 1979 that was transmitted to the Congress pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974.

The special message proposed two new deferrals totalling about \$664 million, and revisions to a previously proposed deferral as follows:

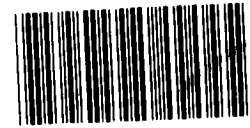
